Participant Submission Guidelines

Participation Eligibility - Participants must have a strong interest in the Visual Arts and be between the ages of 6 – 19.

Categories

- Painting / Oil Pastels
- Illustration / cartooning / stop motion
- Photography
- Sculpture (3-models, clay, papier-mache)
- Video imaging (a work of visual art that combines more than one medium)

Requirements

- Number of entries is limited to 3 per student
- Entries must be the original work from the young artist
- Please have each piece display ready (each piece should be ready for install)
- Please complete entry form (each entry form should be securely attached form to the works' back or bottom)
- Please complete labels (each work should have its own label)
- Works that are placed to tag board or poster board will be accepted
- There is no size limit to works entered
- Pedestals and bases will be provided for sculptures
