2017-2018 Guide for Student Success

- 1. Be on time to class- School policy will be adhered to at all times! Plan accordingly! Be in your seat, have materials out, and pencils sharpened when the bell rings.
- 2. Show Respect- For yourself, your classmates, instructor, and other school staff at all times. Materials, supplies and the art studio are also included.
- 3. Attend class everyday- the major reason students fail is by not coming to class everyday and not completing all of their work. If you are absent, it is your responsibility to find out what you missed and make sure you get the work made up!
- 4. Come prepared for class- you must bring a mechanical pencil with you to class each day.
- 5. Sit in your assigned seat- unless instructed otherwise. You should be in your seat when the tardy bell rings and should stay there until dismissed by the instructor.
- 6. Be attentive to the instructor/speaker- Listen closely at all times to the instructor or to anyone who is presenting to the class or answering a question. Your undivided attention is important to your success.
- 7. Complete and turn in assigned work on time- your grade and success depends on it!
- 8. Pay you art fee- if not, it is the student's responsibility to get the required supplies for the assignments.
- **9. Cell phones and other Electronic devices** all cell phones and other electronic devices should be turned off and put away when the tardy bell rings as per AISD policy. Texting, social media, personal phone calls, video games, & movies in class are explicitly prohibited at all times
- 10. Food and Drinks- No food or drinks are allowed in the Art Studio. Plan accordingly!
- 11. Use appropriate language- Avoid the use of all forms of inappropriate language while in the art studio!
- 12. Talking loudly and immature behavior- maintain control of yourself at all times while in the art studio. Avoid loud talking and immature behavior.
- 13. Off task behavior/sleeping in class- Avoid all forms of off task behavior when in the art studio. Sleeping in class is an off task behavior.
- 14. Clean up is everyone's responsibility- Make sure your area (table and floor) is clean and materials are put away when you leave the studio. Clean-up will not begin any earlier than 5 minutes before the bell rings.
- 15. Make good smart choices at all times!
